

Dear Participant:

You are registered for course # 0307-568, "Drawing on the Right Side of the Brain Costa Rica Style" with Lynda Greenberg at Sueño Azul, Costa Rica on February 10 – 17, 2007. Please bring the following materials for your class:

- ✓ 2B, 4B, 6B drawing pencils
 - ✓ 4B or 6B woodless pencil (this is optional, just a nice tool)
 - ✓ 4B or 6B graphite sticks (the least expensive ones; they are rectangular and about 1/4" by 3-1/2")
 - ✓ Hand-held pencil sharpener (it's a good idea to buy a new one and test it before leaving the art supply store. The ones with little trashcans attached are especially nice.)
 - ✓ Pentel "Click" eraser
 - ✓ Kneaded eraser
 - ✓ Pencil top erasers (these fit on top of your pencils and usually have a nice chisel shape)
- Buy at least ten (10)
- ✓ Vis-à-Vis overhead projector marking pen (water soluble, NOT dry-erase, or permanent)
 - ✓ 14" x 17" Strathmore Drawing Tablet (80#, 400 series, not recycled)
 - ✓ A drawing board or support for the tablet. Faculty uses a piece of tempered Masonite which is about 17" x 20". If you choose something like core foam, make sure it is at least 1/2" thick, so that it doesn't flex when you're drawing.

It is often very difficult to procure drawing tools once the class begins, so try to have a complete set of tools when you arrive for the first workshop session.
