PLEASE NOTE: Weather permitting, there may be an off-site drawing excursion to an historic Hudson location on Wednesday, which will go through the lunch hour and into the afternoon. A box lunch will be provided.

Please bring the following materials to class:

- Drawing Pencils: 2B, 4B, 6B
- Vis-a-Vis Overhead Projector Marking Pen (water soluble, NOT dry-erase)
- Colored Pencils (Any brand will do. My favorites are Prisma Color. If you don't already have a set, select a set of primaries: red, yellow, blue, black, and white. Also select two pencils that will work together for a portrait we will do on colored paper. Pencil colors should coordinate somewhat with the colored paper. Consider acquiring a couple of pencil colors that are closely related to the paper color; for example, if you choose blue paper, select a couple of blue pencils: one lighter and one a little darker.)
- Pastels (these are optional. If you don't already have a set, you could pick up a very inexpensive set or just a couple of colors to experiment with.)
- Charcoal, one stick, medium compressed
- 14" x 17" Strathmore Drawing Tablet, 80 lb., 400 series
- 2 sheets of colored paper (Canson is very nice, but anything will work. Avoid canary yellow.)
- Workable Spray Fixative (optional)
- A support of some sort for the larger tablet: a drawing board, foam core, anything that will give the tablet support. A 17" x 20" piece of tempered masonite is preferred or foam core which is at least a half-inch thick.
- Hand-held pencil sharpener
- Pentel click eraser
- Erasers: kneaded, pencil-top, click eraser (white plastic, comes in different brand names)
- Ruler (optional)

PLEASE NOTE: It is difficult to procure supplies after you arrive. You should bring all of these materials with you to your first session on Monday morning.
