PROGRAM DESCRIPTION

Omega Ecological Literacy Immersion Program Building Our Regenerative Future: A 4-Week Certificate Program

Solving today's challenges requires ecological literacy—an understanding of the patterns and principles that underlie all living systems.

In this transformational 4-week residential certificate program, we explore how to restore the health and well-being of our planet and social systems through regenerative design—an innovative, whole systems, place-based approach to problem solving that considers the connections between society, nature, and individuals. Using the 260-acre Omega campus as our classroom, we learn to consciously design our learning goals, our physical and ecological landscapes, and the social systems that support human well-being and carry our designs forward into the future.

While deepening our understanding of place, we examine current global challenges and learn from the solutions that exist at Omega and around the world. Guided by experts in the fields of permaculture, regenerative agriculture, ecological engineering, water and soil science, wilderness awareness, and whole systems design, we discover the potential for building a regenerative future.

Through lectures, discussion, experiential intensives, hands-on projects, field trips, community experience, and personal reflection, we explore ecology from a social, economic, personal and spiritual perspective. In the process we learn approaches and tools that can be applied to creative problem solving anywhere.
