Eligibility: All levels of experience and prior study are welcome. You must be 18 or older to apply. If younger than 18, you can apply if you plan to come with an adult. We are looking for candidates with a high level of maturity and a sincere desire to be part of creating the future they envision for society and our planet. Applicants should think about both what they hope to gain from the program, and how they can help to enhance the experience of others within this learning community.

NOTE: Submitting an application does not register you for the course. When an application has been received, we will send you a confirmation email. Applications will be reviewed upon receipt.

Once you have been notified of acceptance, you will have <u>two weeks</u> to call and confirm your intention to attend the course and pay a \$500 deposit to hold a space in the program.
