3. What experience, if any, do you have with design beyond your experience with ELIP? Please include anything from landscape design experience to using the design process for other purposes.

This is not a paid position, but will give you a chance to sit in on the course again, assist others, and deepen connection with faculty & other alumni. 2013 participants can earn their Permaculture Design Certificate while supporting the program. PA's will receive a tent site & meals free of charge for the month.

It is helpful for program assistants to arrive on Sunday morning to set up their tent site before the rest of the group arrives– but not mandatory. There will be an ELIP faculty meeting with program assistants on Sunday, June 30 before the current group's main arrival window begins at noon.
